During a subsequent visit (a double-period practical lesson) students will participate in a 'cook off' using the signature ingredient. NCYCC will provide the appropriate quantity of the signature item for each participating class. The provision of all other ingredients will be the responsibility of the school/students.

The dishes will be judged by a Panel including the Chef, NCYCC representative and Class Teacher. A prize of "**Lunch for Two**" at the Restaurant/Café of the visiting Chef shall be awarded to the winning entry.
